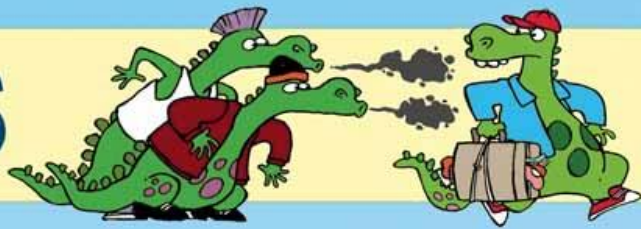

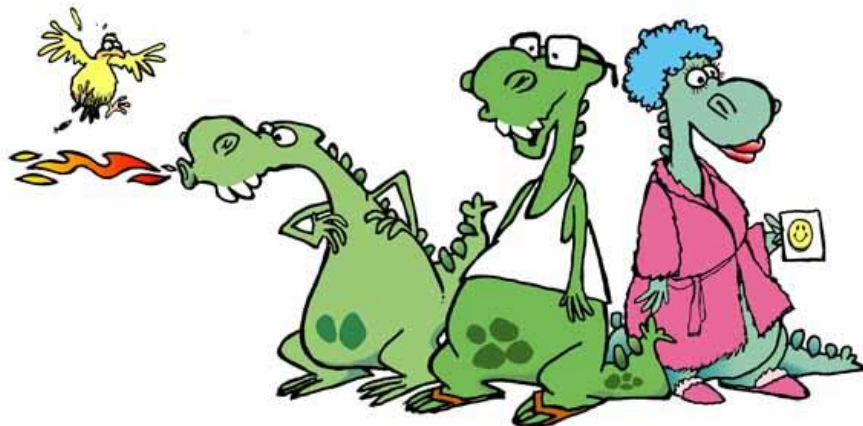

It's not that he could NOT breathe fire (that was not against the rules)

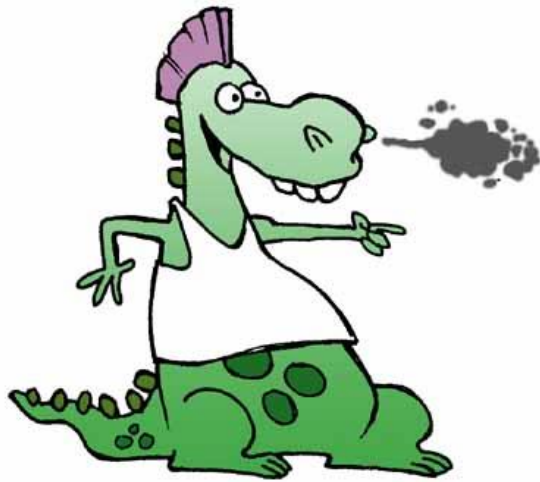
No, you see, our scaly friend just didn't think it cool.

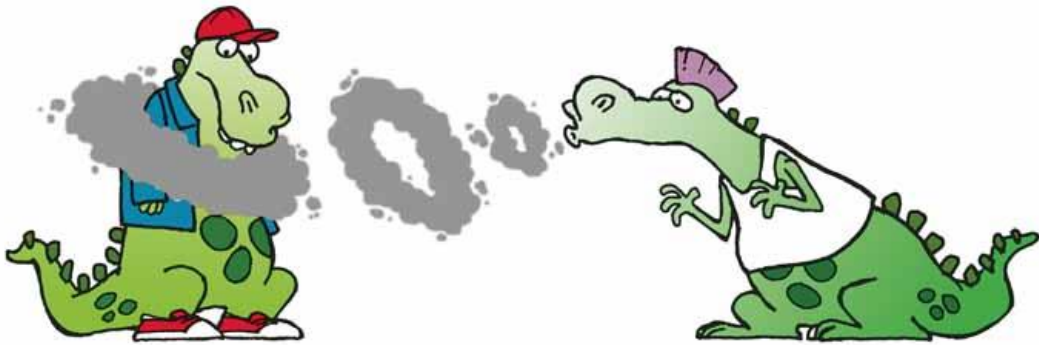
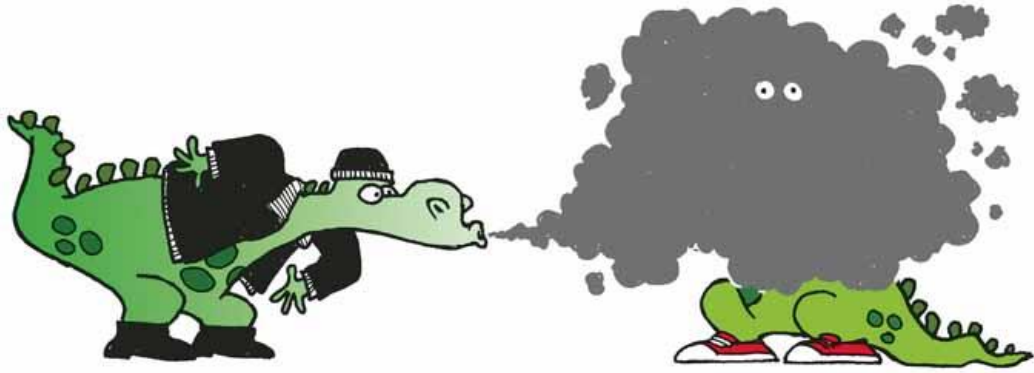
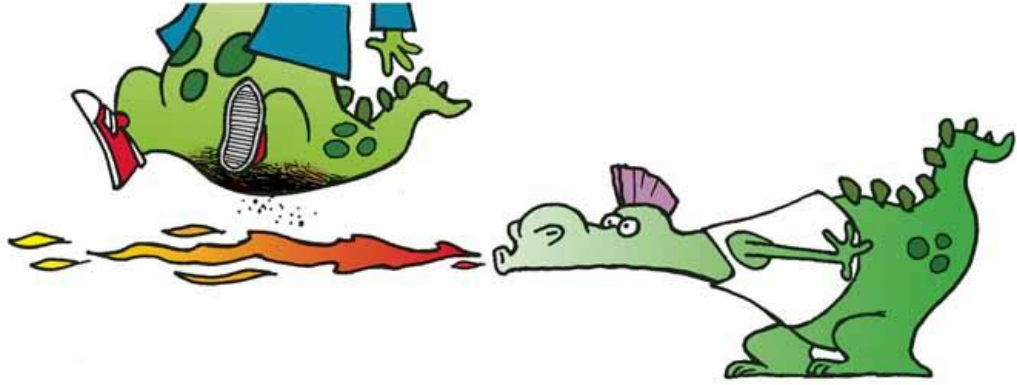




His brothers laughed at his lack of smoky rings

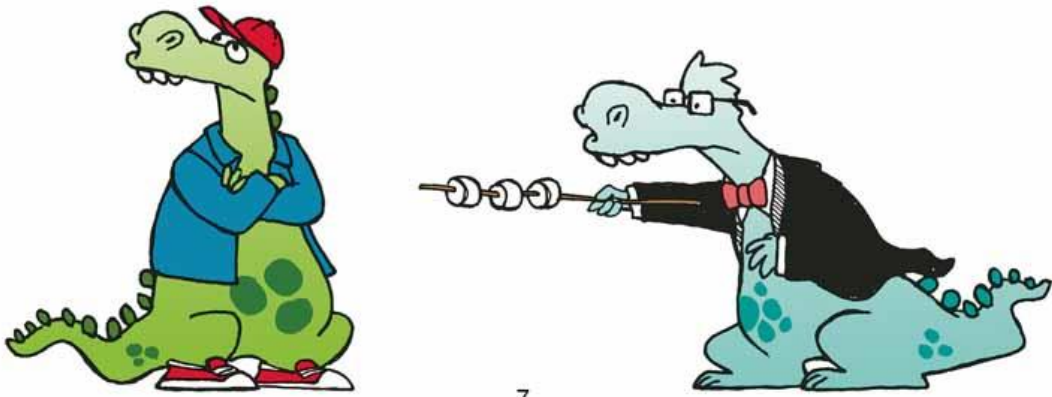
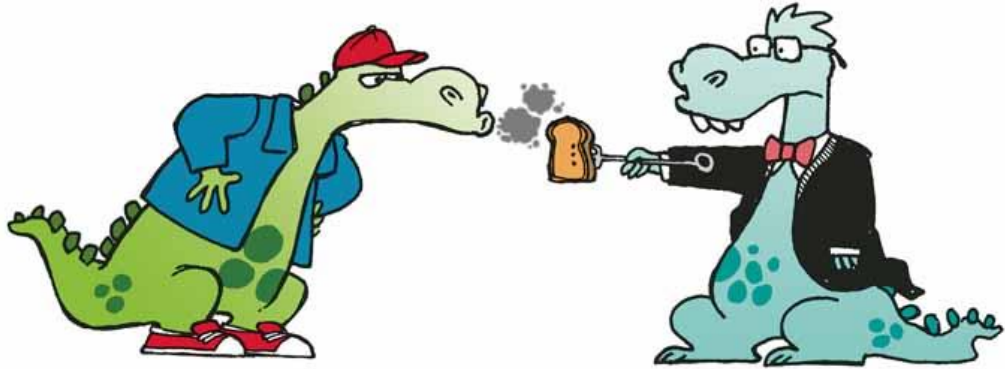
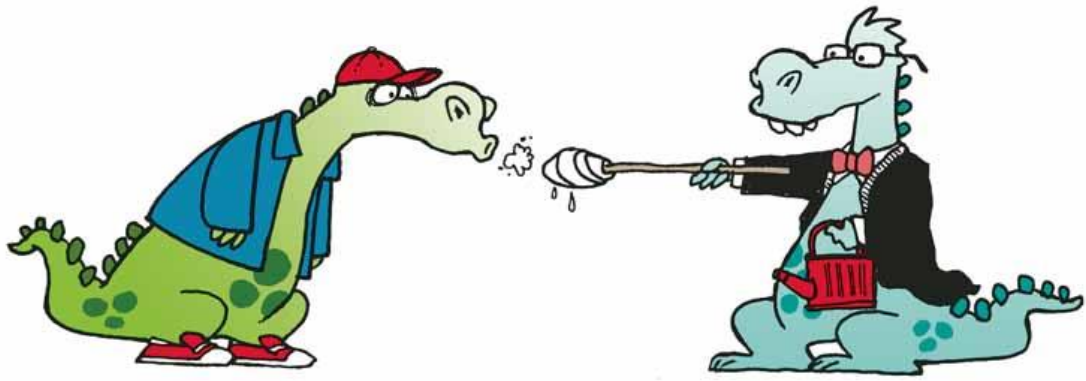
For half the games that dragons play are based upon such things.
